Acrylic Hearts Strawberries Light Chain

Instructions No. 586



You will love these fairy lights: **Acrylic-Hearts** are made Straw silk paper **into glowing strawberries** in this instruction.

And here we go

Remove the eyelets of the Acrylic-hearts carefully with the side cutter. With the metal tip of the hot glue gun - without glue stick! - melt small holes for the light chain into the hearts.

Tip: Melt the holes directly on the seam, this makes it easier to insert the light chain.

Now open the hearts, tear them into Straw silk paper pieces and glue the single pieces with slightly overlapping Napkin varnish glue, let them dry. Transfer the sheets from to solid cardboard and cut them out. Place these cut-out templates on green Felt, border them with a line-ex pencil and cut them out.

With the Cutter cut a slit in the strawberry leaves, pull each over a small lamp, place Acrylic-it in a heart and join the two halves together. Straw silk paper Fill in the free spaces. With the Pearl Put pen dots on the strawberries. After drying, fix the strawberry leaves with hot glue on the strawberries

Glue two Felt-petals with hot glue between each strawberry around the cable, fix small daisy flowers on

them.

Wrap Florist tape the two cables over the strawberries to indicate a stem.
