## **Instructions No. 448**

Difficulty: Advanced

The cheeky angel is quickly recreated and finds its place as Napkin holder on the Christmas table.



Here's how it's done:

Prime the **figure cones** white. While they are drying you can border the angel wings **with gold-coloured** glitter liner. The heads of the figure cones are skin-coloured after the primer has dried. The basket is painted with the colour Orchid, with Grey Brown and a pastel olive green.

Now stick small and large relief motives " stars" **on the** angel bodies. With a Paint sponge Handicraft paint in lvory dab over the stars and the complete figure cones. After the paint has dried, remove the stars from the cones with a needle

Paint **faces** on the angels (colour Fig) Pull the doll's plait apart and glue strands of hair of different lengths onto the heads with hot glue. With scissors and small bows, simply "style" the **hair**.

Glue more stars on the angel's body, fix angel's wings and maybe put another heart on each angel as an accessory.
