

Summer is here

Instructions No. 338



With this creative handicraft idea, you can decide for yourself when the summer begins. **The lettering is designed with Handicraft paint and patch paper**, with these instructions you will succeed in recreating it safely.

It's that easy

Prime the **MDF letters** white and let them dry.

Tear the Décopatch into-Paper small pieces, pick it up with a brush and apply the patch-glue overlapping the letters glue.

Cut a **plywood board** in half lengthwise using a ruler and cutter knife and paint the edges moss green.

Cut the moss plate in half and glue it to the plywood plate with hot glue.

Arrange the **writing** on the plate and fix it with hot glue.

Cut off an approx. 2 cm long **grass pick** lace from and decorate as a tuft around the lettering.

For the **double cherries**, cut pieces of wire of 12 cm each, for the individual cherries cut them to 7 cm each, wrap them with and fix Wooden balls the ends with hot glue in the red ones.

The double cherries to the pair, the individual cherries a hook bend.

Cut out of the Felt sheet leaves and paint Fineliners the leaf veins with green paint, attach to the cherries with hot glue.

Arrange the cherries on the lettering and fix them with hot glue, decorate with a bow of wide ribbon.
