

# Utensil box with napkin technique

Instructions No. 3071

Difficulty: Beginner 🍷🍷🍷🍷

Working time: 3 Hours

The **napkin technique** is very popular and lots of fun. How about a **practical mermaid-style utensil box**? Or you could decorate the box with a rose napkin or astronauts... The possibilities are endless and can be customised to suit your individual wishes.



## How to make the utensil box:

Prime the **VBS utensil box** with white **handicraft paint** primer. Cut out the desired motif section of the **napkin** roughly cut out with scissors. Remove the top printed layer of the napkin and stick it to the utensil box with **napkin varnish** onto the utensil box. To do this, coat one side of the utensil box with the varnish, place the motif on top and coat with the varnish again. Repeat this until all sides are covered. Once dry, cut off the protruding edges of the napkin .

**Tip:** If you want to stick different motifs on one side, carefully tear the motifs out of the napkin and stick them together. Due to the "soft" edges, the transitions are not as clearly visible as with motifs that have been cut out with

scissors.

When everything is dry, you can glue a few scatter decoration with **handicraft glue** to the box. Finally, apply some glitter with the VBS Glitter liner and leave to dry.
