Give your Christmas table a beautiful and luxurious vibe with this beautiful set containing a place-mat and coasters. Crocheted in our favorite yarn to use for Christmas items, Durable Glam, this set promises to be a real eye-catcher on your Christmas table.

Yarn

Durable Glam, 75 % cotton and 25 % polyester, 50g/130m/ 142yd.

Yarn A: 2172 Cream: 6 balls

Yarn B: 2208 Cayenne: 3 balls

Crochet Hook

4 mm / UK 8

Other materials

Scissors

Ruler

Tapestry needle to weave in ends

Pins and mat for blocking

Used stitches and abbreviations US crochet terms

RS	right side
WS	wrong side
ch	chain
ch-sp	chain-space
dc	double crochet
MR	magic ring
Sc	single crochet
slst	slip stitch
st(s)	stitch(es)
tr	treble crochet

Gauge

Not important for this pattern.

Skill level

Starting from beginner.

Measurements

Coaster: 13cm/ 5,12" measured from one of the points to an opposite point.

Place-mat: 40cm/ 15,75" measured from one of the points to an opposite point.

Chart

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Pattern info

- 1ch at the start of a round counts as the first single crochet.
- 2ch at the start of a round counts as the first double crochet. If you crochet your chains tightly, you could also choose to make 3ch at the start of a round.
- Every round is closed with 1slst in the 2ch at the start of that round. This will be described in the pattern as: close.
- Always crochet on the RS of your work, don't turn. Unless noted otherwise.
- Always crochet 1st in a st, unless noted otherwise.

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Pattern Coaster (make 6 pieces)

With Yarn B:

Round 1: RS: Make a magic ring and crochet in the ring: 2ch (= 1st dc from this point), 14dc, close with 1slst in 2ch at the beginning of round.

- total: 15dc

Round 2: RS: 2ch in 1st dc, 1dc in next dc, * (1dc, 3ch, 1dc) in next dc, 1dc in each of next 2sts; repeat from * 3x more, (1dc, 3ch, 1dc) in next dc, close round with 1slst between 2ch and the next dc at the beginning of this round.

- total: 5 sides with each 4dc, 5x 3ch

Round 3: RS: 1ch between 2ch and 1st dc of previous round (counts as 1st sc from this point), skip next st, 1dc in next st, (3dc, 3ch, 3dc) in 3ch-sp, * 1dc in next st, skip next st, 1sc between next 2st, 1dc in next st, (3dc, 3ch, 3dc) in next 3ch-sp ; repeat from * 3x more, 1dc in next st, skip next st, close round with 1slst in 1st ch. Cut thread and fasten off.

- total: 5 sides with each 8dc and 1sc, 5x 3ch

With Yarn A:

Round 4: Attach yarn with 1slst in any sc, 1ch in this sc, skip next st, 1dc in each of next 3sts, (3dc, 1tr, 3ch, 1tr, 3dc) in 1st 3ch-sp, * 1dc in each of next 3sts, skip next st, 1sc in next sc, 1dc in each of next 3sts, (3dc, 1tr, 3ch, 1tr, 3dc) in next 3ch-sp ; repeat from * 3x more, 1dc in each of next 3sts, skip next st, close round with 1slst in 1st ch. Cut thread and fasten off.

- total: 5 sides with each 12dc and 2tr and 1sc, 5x 3ch

Weave in all ends. Make 6 identical coasters.

Pattern Place-mat

With Yarn A:

Rounds 1 - 3: Crochet rounds 1-3 of the pattern for the coasters, but do not fasten off after round 3.

Round 4: RS: 1ch in 1st st, skip next dc, 1dc in each of next 3sts, (3dc, 3ch, 3dc) in 3ch-sp, * 1dc in each of next 3sts, skip next dc, 1sc in next sc, skip next dc, 1dc in each of next 3sts, (3st, 3ch, 3st in next 3ch-sp) ; repeat from * 3x more, 1dc in each of next 3sts, skip next dc, close round with 1slst in 1st ch.

- total: 5 sides with each 12dc and 1sc, 5x 3ch

Round 5: RS: 1ch in 1st st, skip next st, 1dc in each next st until 3ch-sp, (3dc, 3ch, 3dc) in 1st 3ch-sp, * 1dc in each next st until st before sc, skip next st, 1sc in next sc, 1dc in each next st until 3ch-sp, (3dc, 3ch, 3dc) in next 3ch-sp ; repeat from * 3x more, 1dc in each next st until st before sc, skip next st, close round with 1slst in 1st ch.

- total: 5 sides with each 16dc and 1sc, 5x 3ch

Rounds 6 – 11: Repeat round 5.

Attention: At each new round, every side will grow 2dc at the point. Cut thread and fasten off.

With Yarn B:

Round 12: Repeat round 5. (At each new round, every side will grow 2dc at the point)

Round 13: RS: Attach yarn with 1slst in any sc, 1ch in this sc, skip next dc, 1dc in each next st until 3ch-sp (= 21sts), (3dc, 1tr, 3ch, 1tr, 3dc) in 1st 3ch-sp, * 1dc in each next st until st before sc, skip next dc, 1sc in next sc, 1dc in each next st until 3ch-sp, (3dc, 1tr, 3ch, 1tr, 3dc) in next 3ch-sp ; repeat from * 3x more, 1dc in each next st until st before sc, skip next st, close round with 1slst in 1st ch. Cut thread and fasten off.

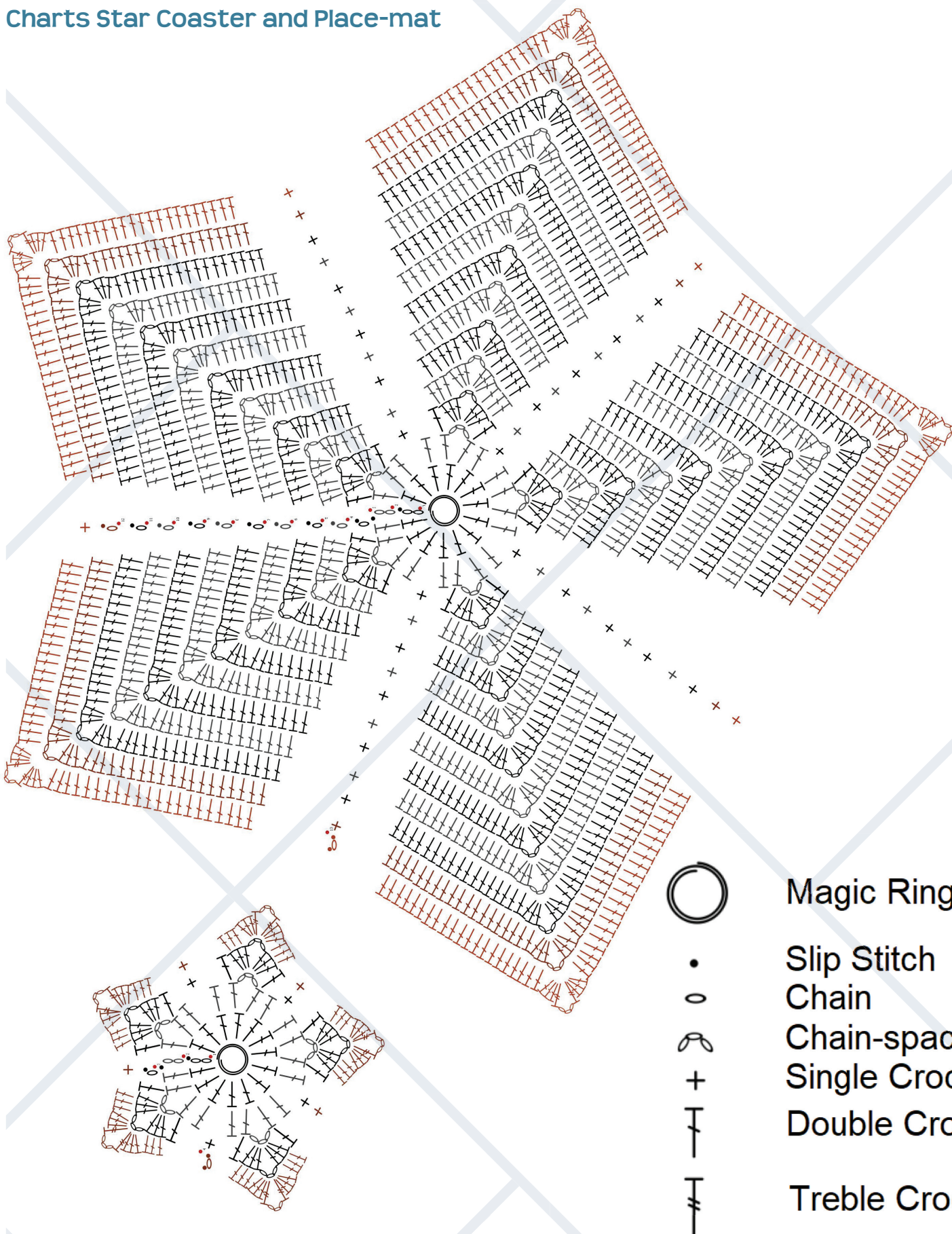
- total: 5 sides with each 48dc and 2tr and 1dc, 5x 3ch

Weave in all ends.
