Must Have Crocheted Cardigan US

This crocheted cardigan is intended to be a very generous fit. The cardigan is made using our new Durable Mohair.

Yarn

Durable Mohair, 55% premium acrylic & 20% wool & 25% mohair, 50g/190m/208yd

Color A: 422 Sesame, 6 (6, 6, 8, 8, 10) balls

Crochet Hook

5mm/ US size H crochet hook, or size needed to achieve gauge.

Other materials

- Measuring tape
- Scissors
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch markers

Used stitches and abbreviations US terms

RS	right side of work
ch	chain
dc	double crochet
dc2tog	double crochet 2 stitches together
sc	single crochet
scbl	single crochet through back loops only
slst	slip stitch
st(s)	stitch(es)



Gauge

15sts and 9 rows to measure 10 x 10cm (4 x 4") using double crochet, using 5mm/US size H hook or size needed to achieve gauge

Pattern

Back

With color A and a 5mm/ US-H hook, 100 (106, 112, 118, 124, 130) ch.

Row 1 (RS): 1dc in fourth ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn

- Total: 98 (104, 110, 116, 122, 128) dc.

Row 2: 3ch (counts as first dc throughout), 1dc in each st to end, turn.

Row 3: 3ch, dc2tog, dc to last 3sts, dc2tog, dc in last st, turn

- Total: 96 (102, 108, 114, 120, 126) dc.

Rows 4-7: As Row 2.

Rows 8-27: Repeat last 5 rows 4 more times

- Total: 88 (94, 100, 106, 112, 118) dc.

Row 28: Repeat row 3

- Total: 86 (92, 98, 104, 110, 116) dc.

Rows 29-31: Repeat row 2.

Rows 32-39: Repeat last 4 rows twice more

- Total: 82 (88, 94, 100, 106, 112) dc.

Row 40: Repeat row 3

- Total: 80 (86, 92, 98, 104, 110) dc.

Row 41: Repeat row 2.

Rows 42-43: Repeat last 2 rows

- Total: 78 (84, 90, 96, 102, 108) dc.

Sizes XL and 2XL only

Rows 44-45: As Row 2.

All Sizes: Fasten off.

Left front

With color A and a 5mm/ US-H hook 50 (53, 56, 59, 62, 65)ch.

Row 1 (RS): 1dc in fourth ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn

- Total: 48 (51, 54, 57, 60, 63) dc.

Row 2: 3ch (counts as first dc throughout), 1dc in each st to end, turn.

Row 3: 3ch, dc2tog, dc in each st to end, turn

- Total: 47 (50, 53, 56, 59, 62) dc.

Rows 4-7: As Row 2.

Row 8: 3ch, dc to last 3 sts, dc2tog, dc in last st, turn

- Total: 46 (49, 52, 55, 58, 61) dc.

Rows 9-12: As Row 2.

Row 13: As Row 3

- Total: 45 (48, 51, 54, 57, 60) dc.

Rows 14-17: As Row 2.

Row 18: As Row 8

- Total: 44 (47, 50, 53, 56, 59) dc.

Rows 19-22: As Row 2.

Row 23: As Row 3

- Total: 43 (46, 49, 52, 55, 58) dc.

Rows 24-27: As Row 2.

Neckline Shaping

Row 28: 3ch, dc2tog, dc to last 3sts, dc2tog, dc in last st, turn

- Total: 41 (44, 47, 50, 53, 56) dc.

Rows 29-31: As Row 2.

Rows 32-35: Repeat last 4 rows once more

- Total: 39 (42, 45, 48, 51, 54) dc.

Row 36: 3ch, dc2tog, dc to last 3sts, dc2tog, dc in last st, turn

- Total: 37 (40, 43, 46, 49, 52) dc.

Row 37: 3ch (counts as first dc throughout), 1dc in each st to end, turn.

Rows 38-43: Repeat last 2 rows 3 times

- Total: 31 (34, 37, 40, 43, 46) dc.

Sizes XL and XL only

Rows 44-45: As Row 2.

All Sizes: Fasten off.

Right front

With color A and a 5mm/ US-H hook 50 (53, 56, 59, 62, 65) ch.

Row 1 (RS): 1dc in fourth ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn

- Total: 48 (51, 54, 57, 60, 63) dc.

Row 2: 3ch (counts as first dc throughout), dc in each st to end, turn.

Row 3: 3ch, dc to last 3 sts, dc2tog, dc in last st, turn

- Total: 47 (50, 53, 56, 59, 62) dc.

Rows 4-7: Repeat Row 2.

Row 8: 3ch, dc2tog, dc in each st to end, turn

-Total: 46 (49, 52, 55, 58, 61) dc.

Complete as for Left Front to end, referring to Row 3 and Row 8 as written for Right Front in the repeats.

Sleeves

The Cuff is worked back and forth in rows, then joined to form a tube.

Main part of Sleeve is worked into row ends of Cuff piece in the round.

Cuff

With color A and a 5mm/ US-H hook, 14ch.

Row 1 (RS): 1sc in second ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn

- Total: 13sc.

Row 2: 1ch (does not count as st throughout), scbl to end, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until there are a total of 25 (25, 30, 30, 30, 32) rows.

Fasten off leaving a long tail and use whip stitch to sew last row to foundation ch to join into a tube.

Fasten off.

Main sleeve

Worked in rounds, turning after every round.

Join yarn in seam of Cuff with RS facing, ready to work into row ends of Cuff.

Round 1 (RS): 1ch, 1sc in each row end of Cuff, slst to first sc, turn

- Total: 25 (25, 30, 30, 30, 32) sc.

Round 2: 3ch (counts as first dc throughout), 1dc in same sc, 2dc in each sc around, slst to top of begin 3ch, turn

- Total: 50 (50, 60, 60, 60, 64) dc.

Round 3: 3ch, 1dc in same st, 1dc in next st, [2dc in next st, 1dc] around, slst to top of begin 3ch, turn

- Total: 75 (75, 90, 90, 90, 96) dc.

Rounds 4-17: 3ch, dc in each st around, slst to top of begin 3ch.

Round 18: 3ch, 2 (2: 2: 2: 3) dc, dc2tog, [3dc, dc2tog] around, slst to top of begin 3ch, turn

- 60 (60, 72, 72, 72, 77) dc.

Repeat round 4 until total Sleeve, including Cuff, measures 52 (51, 49, 48, 47, 46) cm or 20¼, 20, 19¼, 19, 18½, 18".

Fasten off.

To finish

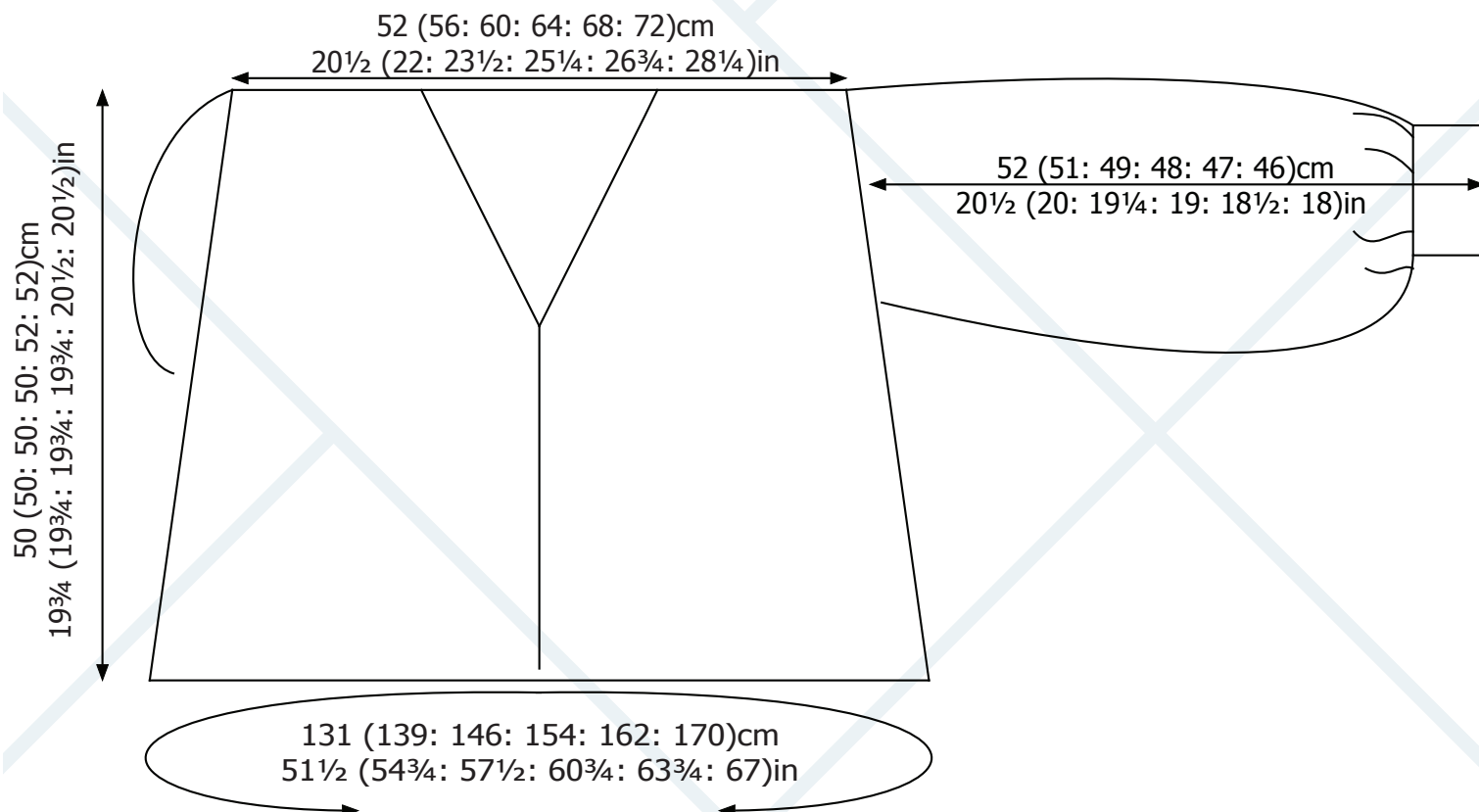
Join at shoulders, matching Fronts and Back stitch for stitch. Sew in sleeves. Join underarm and Sleeve seam.

Work 1 row of sc around front edge and neck. Fasten off and weave in all ends.
