

Striped bobble scarf

This amazing striped scarf is made with simple single crochet stitches. The bobbles in the scarf are a nod to snowballs and snowball fights on chilly winter days. You can easily customize the length and width of this scarf.

Yarn

Durable Mohair, 55% premium acrylic & 25% mohair & 20% wool, 50g/190m/208yd

Color A: 326 Ivory, 8 balls

Color B: 319 Blue, 2 balls

Color C: 343 Warm Taupe, 6 balls

Crochet hook

6mm / US size 10 / UK size 4 crochet hook

Other materials

Scissors, darning needle, 45mm / 1.77" pompom maker

Used stitches and abbreviations (US terms)

bs	bobble stitch
t-ch	turning chain
ch	chain
st(s)	stitch(es)
sc	single crochet

Measurements

Length: 220cm / 86.6"

Width: 50cm / 19.7"



Pattern info

- The entire scarf is made with two strands of yarn (in the same color) held together.
- The design is divided into two parts, so that the repeating pattern will remain visible when wearing the stripes and bobble scarf.
- The first part is worked by crocheting four stripes, with a bobble row in one of the last rows of each stripe. In the second part, a bobble row is worked in one of the first rows of the four stripes.
- The bobble row is only worked in the Ivory-colored stripes, and consists of 19 bobbles.
- The middle Ivory-colored stripe has 2 bobble rows in color B: one at the beginning of the stripe and one at the end of the stripe.
- The bobble stitch consists of 5 unfinished double crochet stitches and a chain stitch. The chain stitch is used as a stitch in the next row. The stitch that is created by working the bobble stitch is not used as a stitch in the next row. This will allow you to push the bobble to the outside of your work to make it "pop" and keep it in place.

Pattern

Work 59ch using two strands held together in color A.

Row 1: 1t-ch, 59sc.

Rows 2-30: Repeat row 1, switch to color B at the end of row 30.

Row 31: 1t-ch, *2sc, 1bs, repeat from * to last 2sts, work 1sc in each of last 2sts, switch to color A.

Row 32: 1t-ch, 3sc, skip 1s (this is the bobble stitch, push the bobble to the outside), *3sc, skip 1s, repeat from * to last 2sts, work 1sc in each of last 2sts.

Rows 33-34: Repeat row 1, switch to color C at the end of row 34.

Rows 35-68: Repeat row 1, switch to color A at the end of row 68.

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Rows 69-98: Repeat row 1, switch to color B at the end of row 98.

Row 99: 1t-ch, *2sc, 1bs*, repeat from * to last 2sts, work 1sc in each of last 2sts, switch to color A.

Row 100: 1t-ch, 3sc, skip 1s (this is the bobble stitch, push the bobble to the outside), *3sc, skip 1s, repeat from * to last 2sts, work 1sc in each of last 2sts.

Rows 101-102: Repeat row 1, switch to color C at the end of row 102.

Rows 103-136: Repeat row 1, switch to color A at the end of row 136.

Rows 137-138: Repeat row 1, switch to color B at the end of row 138.

Row 139: 1t-ch, *2sc, 1bs, repeat from * to last 2sts, work 1sc in each of last 2sts, switch to color A.

Row 140: 1t-ch, 3sc, skip 1s (this is the bobble stitch, push the bobble to the outside), *3sc, skip 1s, repeat from * to last 2sts, work 1sc in each of last 2sts.

Rows 141-166: Repeat row 1, switch to color B at the end of row 166.

Row 167: 1t-ch, *2sc, 1bs, repeat from * to last 2sts, work 1sc in each of last 2sts, switch to color A.

Row 168: 1t-ch, 3sc, skip 1s (this is the bobble stitch, push the bobble to the outside), *3sc, skip 1s*, repeat from * to last 2sts, work 1sc in each of last 2sts.

Rows 169-170: Repeat row 1, switch to color C at the end of row 170.

Rows 171-204: Repeat row 1, switch to color A at the end of row 204.

Rows 205-206: Repeat row 1, switch to color B at the end of row 206.

Row 207: 1t-ch, *2sc, 1bs, repeat from * to last 2sts, work 1sc in each of last 2sts, switch to color A.

Row 208: 1t-ch, 3sc, skip 1s (this is the bobble stitch, push the bobble to the outside), *3sc, skip 1s, repeat from * to last 2sts, work 1sc in each of last 2sts.

Rows 209-238: Repeat row 1, switch to color C at the end of row 238.

Rows 239-272: Repeat row 1, switch to color A at the end of row 272.

Rows 273-274: Repeat row 1, switch to color B at the end of row 274.

Row 275: 1t-ch, *2sc, 1bs, repeat from * to last 2sts, work 1sc in each of last 2sts, switch to color A.

Row 276: 1t-ch, 3sc, skip 1s (this is the bobble stitch, push the bobble to the outside), *3sc, skip 1s, repeat from * to last 2sts, work 1sc in each of last 2sts.

Rows 278-308: Repeat row 1, fasten off after working row 308.

Finishing:

Use the pompom maker to make 5 pompoms in color A and 5 pompoms in color B. Leave a long tail to attach the pompoms. Attach the pompoms at the ends of the scarf, alternating between the two colors and mirroring these on the other side. On one end, you will have color A – B – A – B – A and on the other side you will have color B – A – B – A – B.



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
